#### **SECTION 1 - VALUATIONS**

For Building Permit Purposes, valuation for buildings and structures shall be established as prescribed in Section 14.04.050, subparagraph 7 of the Grant County code and shall be per the attached schedule entitled Grant County Building Department February 2014 Valuation Schedule.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED THAT the valuations and fees established and adopted hereby shall take effect and be in full force on March 1, 2014 from and after the date of its final passage.

#### February 2014 Fee Policies

#### **Deposits**

Projects with an estimated value of \$100,000 or more at time of application require a deposit with submittal.

Value estimate is based on adopted fee schedules.

Deposit amount is based on estimated plan review fee.

Deposits are non-refundable after the plan review has been started on the project.

When an applicant change requires submittal of revised plans, after original plan review has been completed, the following fees will apply:

Re-review before permit issuance (with same project scope)

\$ 50 Min

Keep original plan review fee and charge new plan review fee based on new valuation, or \$ 50 min.

Re-review plans after issue - Smaller (with same project scope )

\$ 50 Min

Keep original plan review fee and charge new plan review fee based on new valuation, or \$ 50 min.

Addend

Re-review plans after issue - Same Size (with same project scope)

Re-review for major change of construction only, \$50 per hour, \$50 min; no new permit required

Re-review plans after issue - Larger (with same project scope)

New permit for additional area, current fees

New Pmt

Re-review plans with change of project scope - Before or After Issue

New App or Pmt

New application / permit for new scope of project if substantially different

Refunds must be requested in writing within 180 days of payment, or in the case of applications, before the end of the 1st Expiration period noted on Expiration Letter.

#### Applications - prior to plan review initiation

If deposit submitted, refund 80% of deposit.

If full fees submitted, refund 80% of Plan Review Fee & all other fees.

#### Applications - after plan review initiation

If deposit submitted, keep Deposit.

If full fees submitted, keep Plan Review Fee. Refund other fees.

### Permits - after issuance

Keep Plan Review, State Bldg Code Fee and 20% of Permit Fee. Refund other fees.
